"The Annual World Children's Picture Contest" would like to invite you to participate in the international picture contest held by IE-NO-HIKARI. Through the picture art, we focus on children to understand the importance of food that we need to live and teach the value of family, friendship and different communities.

Themes

Works can be on any theme to support self-expression.

Entry Period

June 1 – October 2, 2021
The picture must be received by this date.

Eligible Participants

6-15 years old

Rules

- The picture must be on flat paper less than 728mm×515mm×3mm, and should not be framed or matted.
- Picture can be made from any materials and methods.
- Contest participants are limited to enter one picture each.
- All picture submitted must be the unreleased "original-sole work".
- Works determined by the Association to be highly likely to infringe the rights of others, such as those that are deemed to imitate pictures, photographs, and characters, as well as those that contain specific characters, personal names, company names, product names, logos, etc., are outside of the scope of judging.
- All artworks must be original hard copies. Photo prints and e-mail attachments should not be submitted.
- No picture received will be returned to sender for any reason.
- All rights to pictures will belong to the host organization.
- In some cases, children's pictures submitted will be loaned out for activities and events promoting children's art education and international exchange, etc. held in Japan.



Comments from ADESC Brazil

(Associação Cultural dos Departamentos de Senhoras Cooperativistas)

We have participated in the "World Children's Picture Contest" for the past 28 years. Every year, about 350 pieces from 35 schools are submitted; however, this year, because of the spread of COVID-19, 79 pieces from nine schools were submitted. This year, we went ahead with the selection via e-mails and telephone calls with teachers. Drawings were sent to teachers' homes and the selection process proceeded. While there were fewer participants, the event was meaningful for children, and all ADESC members were very pleased as well. The following are comments from two teachers.

Nishimura Chiseko, President of ADESC

Every year, we choose pieces from among pictures drawn during the year, but this year we chose only one, as classes were held only until March due to the coronavirus pandemic. Whatever happens, we would very much appreciate it if IE-NO-HIKARI Association continued to hold the "World Children's Picture Contest," which is a ray of hope for children.
